

Medical Intelligence Tech expands to Spain and Britain

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Quebec City mobile telesecurity specialist Medical Intelligence Technologies Inc. said today it began deliveries of second-generation products to distributors in Spain and Britain during the third quarter and has since expanded its European footprint by additional licensing pacts in Germany and Britain. Revenue for the quarter was \$395,000, up from \$27,000 a year earlier, and the loss was \$2.47 million against a loss of \$2.02 million a year earlier. The current fourth quarter will show higher revenue and "we plan to expand into new growth markets," said CEO Philippe Huneault.
